RESOLUTION NO. 93-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HARDEE COUNTY, FLORIDA TO CONDUCT A REFERENDUM AT THE 1992 GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING ELECTOR APPROVAL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPECIAL DISTRICT FOR INDIGENT HEALTH CARE WITH AUTHORITY TO ANNUALLY LEVY AD VALOREM TAXES.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Hardee County, Florida has received a request from Hardee Memorial Hospital to create an independent special district for the purpose of providing funding for indigent health care; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 154.331, Florida Statutes, in order to establish an independent special district for the purpose of providing funding for indigent health care with authority to annually levy ad valorem taxes, the county governing body must obtain elector approval; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Hardee County, Florida deems it to be in the interests of the public health, safety and welfare to establish a special district for the funding of indigent health care in Hardee County, with authority to levy annual ad valorem taxes up to one (1) mill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Hardee County, Florida, as follows:

1. A referendum for the purpose of obtaining elector approval for the establishment of a special district for the purpose of funding indigent health care in

Hardee County, shall be placed on the November 3, 1992, election ballot.

2. The referendum shall be in the form and language as follows:

REFERENDUM FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INDIGENT HEALTH CARE SPECIAL DISTRICT

Should the Board of County Commissioners of Hardee County establish an independent special district with authority to annually levy ad valorem taxes not to exceed one (1) mill, for the purpose of providing funding for indigent health care in Hardee County?


